

The Green Bay Water Utility will soon flush water mains in your neighborhood. This is part of our Unidirectional Flushing Program to remove settled particles and clean underground water mains. We do this to help maintain water quality for you and your family.

When we conduct flushing in your neighborhood, you will notice blue sign boards on the street that say **Water Main Flushing** on them. Here are a few tips/things to be mindful of when you see us:

- If possible, do not use your water when we are flushing your neighborhood. If you do need to use water, run the cold water first until the water is clear.
- You might notice a reduction in water pressure in your faucets and showers. This is normal.
- When we are done with flushing (you see us pack up and leave your neighborhood), we recommend running your cold water for a few minutes to clear out the system. Then you can resume using your water as you normally would.

Flushing typically takes about a half hour.
